Information on a survey on the scientific activity in the year 2023 among the Employees¹ of the FAIS Faculty of the Jagiellonian University

As in previous years, survey respondents can report:

- 1) Up to five selected research works published in the years 2019–2023², stating the total citation count³ in the years 2019–2023 for each of them.
- 2) Papers, monographs and textbooks published in the year 2023².
- 3) The count of citations³ that all research works of the Employee, taken together, received in the year 2023 (only citations from 2023, not the sum over many years).
- 4) Oral presentations personally delivered by the Employee at conferences or scientific congresses in the year 2023, with the title of the presentation, its type (plenary, invited, etc.), the name, place, date and (optionally) website of the conference.
- 5) Grants in which the Employee is either a coordinator or an investigator, with the title of the grant, the funding institution, and the grant coordinator.
- 6) Participation in boards of foreign or international scientific associations, organizations and institutions whose members are from at least 10 countries, with the name of the organisation, the position held, and the year of appointment.
- 7) Participation in expert panels, with the name of the panel, the year of appointment, the appointing authority or institution, and a one-sentence description of panel's tasks.
- 8) Prizes and awards, with the name of the prize, the co-winners if it was a group prize, the person or institution awarding the prize, the type of the prize (scientific, teaching, other), and the country in which the prize was awarded.
- 9) The most important achievement in the year 2023 (research result, grant, publication, conference presentation, prize).
- 10) Additional information on scientific activities in the year 2023, which in the Employee's opinion is relevant.

The collected data will be statistically analyzed by the Faculty Commission; the resulting report will be delivered to the University authorities.

¹ The survey concerns the Employees working as academic teachers (assistants, assistant professors, professors) in the research staff group or the research and teaching staff group, in research-technical positions full-time or part-time (at least $\frac{1}{2}$ time), as well as Employees in engineering-technical positions working full-time or part-time who, within the scope of their duties, perform auxiliary work in scientific research as well as service and research work, with the exception of those working at the Faculty for less than 6 months. The Employees will be asked to personally enter the above data online via the website. In order to promote the scientific achievements of the University, the obtained data will be (only with the Employee's consent) published on the Faculty's public website.

² The works must be registered in the Jagiellonian University Repository (RUJ). Jagiellonian University must be specified as the author's affiliation.
